Accommodations and travel details

Where is the Textile ETP taking place?

The 18th Textile ETP Annual Conference will take place at the Lamot Congress and Heritage Centre, located at Van Beethovenstraat 8/10, 2800 Mechelen, Belgium.

How to get there?

Mechelen is a charming Belgian town, located 25km away from Brussels, Belgium. It is easily accessible by public transport and taxi from Brussels airport and city centre:

- **From Brussels Airport:**
 - By train: Brussels Airport railway station is on level -1. A direct express train will take you to Mechelen Central station in just 11 minutes! A ticket costs €10.40.
 - By bus: Brussels Airport bus station is on level 0. De Lijn provides a direct bus service to Mechelen station twice an hour, including lines 282, 681, 682, 683 and 686. The bus journey takes 45 minutes. A ticket costs around €3.
 - By taxi: Brussels Airport taxi station is on level 0. The journey takes approximately 25 minutes. The ride costs around €50-60.
- **From Brussels city centre:**
 - By train: Mechelen can be reached from the 3 main train stations of Brussels (Brussels Midi, Brussels Central and Brussels North). Direct trains will bring you to Mechelen Central station in 15-30 min depending on the Brussels station where you board the train. A ticket costs €5.50.
 - By taxi: Taxis are available throughout the city. The journey takes approximately 45 minutes. The ride costs around €70-80.
